Location and Information

The Troop will camp at the Kelsey Short Campground, Smithville Lake. This campout is **Camporee** with the skills competition scheduled for Saturday. All Scouts should bring proper clothing and gear for the fall camping season suitable for weather changes.

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Departure:

The Troop will meet at Liberty United Methodist Church on Friday, October 18th @ **6:00 PM** for check-in & departure. The Troop will return to Crowley Furniture parking lot around 11:00am on Sunday, October 20th. **If you plan to arrive late, leave early or leave during the campout, you MUST let the Camping Coordinators, Clint Cook or Mike Greenwald, or Scoutmaster, Mike Riley, know during sign-up or check-in.**

Directions: Travel **North** on Hwy 291 to A Hwy (first right after I-35), turn right (**North**), travel 7 miles on Hwy A to Hwy 92, at the junction of Hwy 92, turn left (**West**), travel 1.8 miles to Hwy E and turn right (**North**). Follow the road 2.9 miles to the Camp Branch sign (**Collins Road**) and turn right, travel 2.5 miles to the entrance to the Kelsey Short Camp area on your right. You will be directed to the parking area.

Food/Cooking Format:

Scouts by Patrol. We recommend a quick cooked lunch for Saturday. On Saturday evening, **ALL PATROLS** will eat with the Leaders for dinner Saturday evening, HOWEVER, each Patrol WILL prepare a Dutch Oven dessert, to be entered into the Camporee Competition & the balance to be eaten for dessert following dinner.
